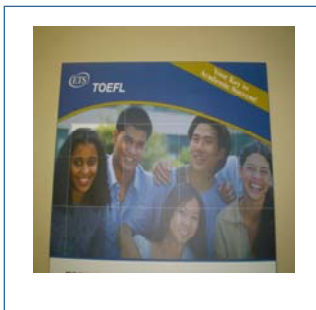

Grammar
