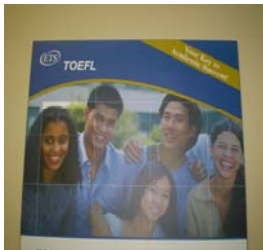

B: I think it's out of gas. Or I think we are out of gas.

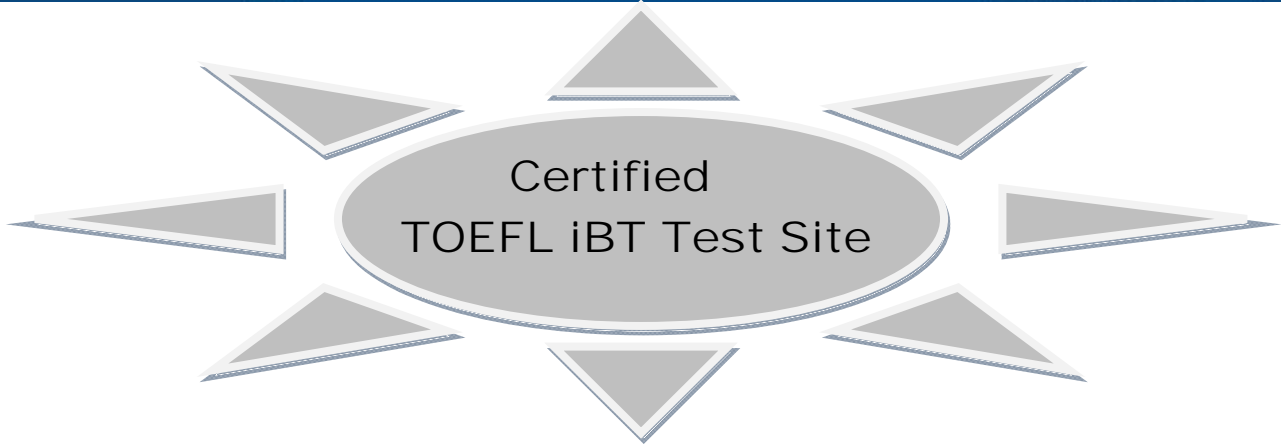
